

Constantine "Deno" Macricostas Chairman of the Board and Founder

Deno Macricostas, RagingWire's chairman, is the founder, chairman, and largest single shareholder of Photronics, Inc. (NASDAQ: PLAB), the world's largest supplier of photomasks, a key enabling technology in the semiconductor industry. He brings RagingWire 40 years of senior level technical, business and financial management experience, with a successful record in building public companies. After coming to the U.S., attending college and serving in the Army, Mr. Macricostas began his business career in 1960 as a design engineer for National Semicon-ductor. In 1969, following work as an engineering manager for Qualitron, he designed early photomask making equipment prior to starting Photronics. Mr. Macricostas has played important roles in other startup businesses: he was an early investor and board member of Nutmeg Savings and Loan, Colonial Data and Orbit Semiconductor. He has received many awards, including the Small Business Administration's National Entrepreneurial Success Award, the High Tech Entrepreneur of the Year, and the Eli Whitney Award for Excellence in Small Business Management. He is listed in Who's Who in American Business, and has been recognized by President Clinton and the executives of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.
